EMORY LOUIS CARTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Emory Louis Carter was a native of Knoxville, Tennessee. He was born October 27th, 1928 and attended school in Knox County, graduating from Austin High School in 1947. He was initiated as a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. in 1949. Emory attended Knoxville College where he graduated in 1951 with a Bachelors of Arts Degree. After graduating from college Emory enlisted in the Army and spent 2 years in the military serving during the Koren War. He received an honorable discharge in 1953. Emory was active in his community, serving on Sertoma Learning Center Housing Board, Knox County Retired Teachers Association and Beck Cultural Exchange Center. Faithful member of Rogers Memorial Baptist Church. Serving on the Board of Deacons and Congregational Song Leader. Keeper of Records & Exchequer for the South Central Province of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. A Long Time Member of the Knoxville Alumni Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. till his death March 23^d, 1990. Emory was a life-long educator and retired from the Knox County Schools System having taught at Bearden Middle School. Because of his passion and commitment to education, the Emory Louis Carter Memorial Scholarship is dedicated in his honor.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must have a 3.25 grade point average on a 4.00 scale (No Rounding Up of GPA)
- Must be a male who is graduating from a Knoxville Area (Knox, Anderson or Blount County) High School

Eligibility Requirements

- Must submit an official high school transcript
- Must submit one letter of reference from (Teacher, Principal, Counselor, etc.)
- Must be willing to participate in a virtual interview with members of the Scholarship Committee
- Must be a college freshman accepted to an accredited two or 4 year college or university entering the 2021-2022 School year

- The scholarship check will be rewarded after the recipient has provided proof of registration at the designated College or University
